



# SWAT Operator II

9<sup>th</sup> Session

This is the second course in the CCJTA SWAT Operator series. The focus is to prepare officers to participate in tactical operations that occur in a woodland or rural environment. SWAT snipers will find this course useful to refine their fieldcraft skills. Special emphasis is placed on how SWAT teams can utilize mutual aid concepts to resolve woodland tactical operations. This course is limited to a maximum of 8 students.

Officers will receive 48 hours DCJS in-service credit

## Topics:

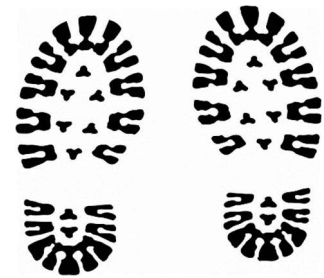
- Land navigation with map, compass & GPS

- Integration of K9 tracking assets
- Shooting skills for rural operations
- Patrolling techniques
- Rural surveillance/take down operations
- High risk manhunt operations

- 200 rounds long gun & 50 rounds handgun ammunition
