12th Session

This is the second course in the CCJTA SWAT Operator series. The focus is to prepare officers to participate in tactical operations that occur in a woodland or rural environment. Special emphasis is placed on how SWAT teams can utilize mutual aid concepts to resolve woodland tactical operations. This course is limited to a maximum of 8 students.

Officers will receive 48 hours DCJS in-service credit

Topics:

- Land navigation with map, compass & GPS
- Map coordinate systems
- Visual tracking
- Integration of K9 tracking assets
- Shooting skills for rural operations
- Patrolling techniques
- Rural surveillance operations
- Man tracking operations

- Duty long gun with sling & 3 magazines
- Duty handgun with holster & 3 magazines
- 200 rounds long gun & 50 rounds handgun ammunition
- Utility uniforms suitable for rural operations
- Small backpack
