

Training Response Network (TRN) Domains for Whitelisting and Firewall Access

Updated: January 1, 2024

To use TRN Training, agencies must allow:

- Content delivered in iframes (from servers listed below)
- Third-party videos and images (from servers listed below)
- Third-party videos and images delivered from an iframe (from servers listed below)
- Ajax calls to lms.trnpc.com and dash.trnpc.com
- JavaScript and jQuery
- Reading and writing cookies, sessions and local storage

Servers

TRN training requires access to these domains:

*.trninc.net (1)

*.trnpc.com (1)

*.trntraining.com (1)

*.kxcdn.com (1)

- These **four domains** above are current and/or new. The kxcdn domain delivers media from KeyCDN. The other three are for training, communication, and new features.

The course modules are loaded from lms.trnpc.com and the assessment calls an API from lms.trnpc.com.

When the user logs-in to trnpc.com and selects a course, the course's content is displayed in an iframe. **NOTE:** This iframe content is loaded from a **combination** of **dash.trnpc.com** and ***.kxcdn.com**
