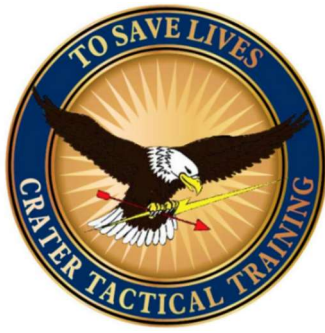




SWAT Sniper II

1st Session

The Crater Criminal Justice Training Academy, SWAT Sniper II is the companion course to our SWAT Sniper I. SWAT Sniper II will develop additional skills necessary to perform law enforcement sniper operations with an emphasis on preparing officers to participate in rural operations and public events. This is not a basic sniper course. Students must have completed a basic law enforcement sniper course prior to attending SWAT Sniper II and possess the pre-requisite marksmanship skills listed. **Virginia officers will receive 40 hours DCJS in-service training credit.**

Pre-requisites:

- Prior completion of any basic law enforcement sniper course
- Ability to fire duty sniper rifle within a 1" circle at 100 yards from a prone supported position (bipod or bag)
- Ability to fire duty sniper rifle **unsupported** from standing, kneeling, sitting and prone positions within a 6" circle at 50 yards

Topics include:

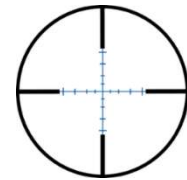
- Range firing out to 200 yards
- Moving target engagement
- Use of tripods
- Firing through residential glass barriers
- Use of Hold overs
- Land navigation with map, compass and GPS
- Patrolling for sniper operations
- Sniper mission planning and deployment for public events (parades, concerts, festivals, demonstrations, etc.)
- Sniper mission planning and deployment for rural operations
- Advanced deadly force decision making for law enforcement snipers

Required equipment:

- Match grade rifle equipped with a scope capable 1/10 MILRADIAN or 1/4 MOA adjustments
- 200 open air rounds, match grade rifle ammunition
- 20 glass barrier rounds, match grade rifle ammunition
- Small backpack
- Shooting mat or ground tarp
- Rifle cleaning supplies

Provided for students' use by CCJTA:

- Land navigation tools: maps, compasses and GPS units
