



Law Enforcement Protective Operations

4th Session

This 5-day course prepares officers to participate in local protective operations for a high-profile dignitary, witness or prisoner. Protective operations that have national implications will also be reviewed with a special emphasis on local law enforcement's role in these operations. The material is presented using lectures, multiple field exercises, range work and a final scenario.

- Arrivals & departures
- Motorcade operations
- Protective intelligence
- Concentric rings of security
- Surveillance & countermeasures
- Advances
- Mission planning
- Protective detail scenario

- 200 rounds handgun ammunition
