Topics:

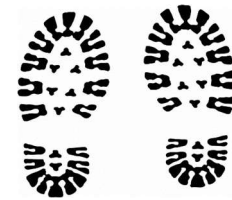
- Land navigation with map, compass & GPS

- Introduction to visual tracking
- Integration of K9 tracking assets
- Shooting skills for man tracking operations
- Patrolling techniques
- Rural surveillance operations
- Coordination with drone teams
- Tracking team tactics

Required Equipment:

- Duty long gun with sling & 3 magazines
- Duty handgun with holster & 3 magazines
- 200 rounds long gun & 50 rounds handgun ammunition
- Utility uniforms suitable for rural operations
- Small backpack
